PARKING DURING SCHOOL DROP OFF & PICK UP

Unfortunately we are having to include another reminder to drivers who drop off & pick up their sons & daughters on the roads surrounding Fullbrook. Since the start of the new school year we have received a number of comments about cars stopping in places that are dangerous, against highway regulations, and a lack of courtesy for our neighbours who might need to leave or get onto their properties.

Our primary concern is for the safety of our students, and the congestion that occurs during pick up and drop off times continues to put them at risk. In the coming weeks we will be asking Runnymede Borough Council Parking Enforcement to assist with the issue. In the meantime, we are asking for drivers to show consideration, and to help ease the traffic issues by adopting the voluntary one way system (please see page 4 of the newsletter) and parking on one of the surrounding roads.
