
**COMPLEMENT** (verb): to make something else better or more attractive when combining with it (do not confuse with 'compliment' which means a remark that expresses approval or admiration).

Initially, we will be inviting **New Starters** (new to the School) throughout the month of June. You will be able to book your appointment from **Friday 5th June 2020**.

#### In Store Appointments- New Starters Only: 15th June- 30th June

All booking options will only be available on our website, 2 weeks in advance of the date of appointment. Please visit **www.sud.co.uk** to book your appointment.

Available options for booking will be;

- 1 Child 30 min slot
- 2 Children 45 min slot
- 3 Children 1 hour slot

#### **Uniform Packs & Early Bird Offers**

#### **Ordering Online**

You can continue to place your orders online in the usual way, and can opt to have your uniform delivered to your home or work address. Please note- We are currently running with limited staff, so delivery periods are extended.

#### Click & Collect Service

Due to Covid-19 we are unable to provide normal Click & Collect services, please read the following information on the new procedures:

- 1) Place your Click & Collect order online as normal.
- 2) You will receive an email confirmation this means we have received your order.
- 3) Once your order is ready to be sent to the store (minimum of 5 working days), you will be sent another email "Your Order has been Dispatched"
- 4) Your order will then be transported to your chosen store
- 5) Once you receive a "Your order has been dispatched" email, you must arrange an appointment to come and collect your parcel visit www.schooluniformdirect.co.uk/booking to arrange an appointment.
