CYCLE PERMITS

All students who ride a bike to school and wish to keep their bike on site, must obtain a new bicycle permit letter from Mrs Mason at the beginning of every new academic year. The letter must be signed and returned to Mrs Mason who will issue a permit. There will be further availability of bicycle storage from October. However, students should obtain their permits now as numbers will continue to be limited and demand is currently very high to secure bicycles on site. All students with permits must follow the permit regulations which include wearing a cycle helmet at all times and never riding a bicycle whilst on site.

Students who do not have a permit will need to keep their bicycles off site. There is a bike rack available at West Byfleet Railway station, which is a five minute walk from school.

CORONA VIRUS TESTING
