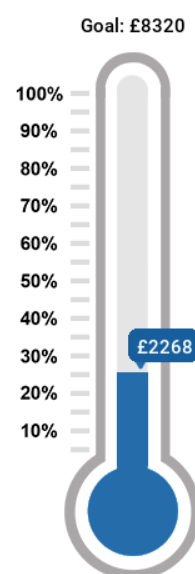
SCIENCE STOOL FUNDRAISING UPDATE

SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL TRAVEL SURVEY
