On Monday 9 November Fullbrook received an extremely thoughtful donation from a local businessman. Mr. Sunil Khadka, who owns the New Haweli restaurant in West Byfleet, approached the school before half term with an offer to present the school with personal hand sanitiser bottles for every student and member of staff.

Students from Year 7 and the Fullbrook 6 Student Leadership Team joined Mrs Moore to receive the socially distanced delivery from Mr Khadka on Monday morning.



The 1600 personal hand sanitiser bottles, which can easily be clipped onto school bags or staff lanyards will be distributed in the coming weeks, and are a handy reminder for everyone at the school about the renewed importance of keeping safe during the latest lockdown period.
