Transmission of COVID - Hall	Low	- Students will sit in chairs that are spaced out.
Transmission of COVID - Classroom & lessons	Low	 Year 5 students will be in a maximum of 2 classrooms during their visit. Year 5 students will be using the empty year 11 bubble unless they are using a specialist classroom. Specialist classrooms will be sprayed down and cleaned between lessons. Classrooms will be ventilated by having windows open. Teachers and ambassadors will be in their technical area and therefore will maintain 2m social distancing.
Transmission of COVID - PE lessons	Low	- PE lessons will take place outside so minimal risk of transmission.
Transmission of COVID – Social distancing	Low	 One way system in operation in school. Restricted tour of the school, students will be taken around the school mainly from the outside. Lunch will be on the field, away from secondary students. If raining students will have their lunch in an allocated classroom in an empty bubble.
Transmission of COVID - Hand Sanitisers	Low	- Hand sanitiser will be available in ALL classrooms. Students will be expected to use this upon arrival and exit of the room.
Transmission of COVID - Use of toilets	Low	- Year 5 students will have access to the toilets which are located in the girls' and boys' PE changing rooms. These changing rooms are currently out of use to secondary students.
Transmission of COVID – Water Fountains	High	 Water fountains around the school are closed and not in use. Bottled water will be handed out to Year 5 students
