

#### Ski Trip 2022

We are proposing to organise our annual ski trip in February 2022 to Austria for all year groups (subject to COVID restrictions at the time of the trip). We will be using the services of IBT Travel who have been organising school ski trips for over 25 years and have been outstanding with running other schools ski trips.

The trip will depart on Saturday 12 February 2022 and return on Saturday 19 February 2022. Included in the package is round trip coach/ferry travel, 6-night accommodation with dinner & breakfast, 5 days skiing with 5 hours instruction each day, 5 hot lunches in a mountainside cafe, 3 evening entertainments pre-arranged, insurance and hire of ski equipment and ski helmets. The total cost will be approx. £1100 per student and we are looking to take a minimum of 40 students. There will be a balloted process to pick the students should we have more students apply then places available. Please also note that if your child is currently eligible for Free School Meals then financial support is available and can be discussed with me should you wish.

If there is enough interest meaning the trip can go ahead, there will be an information meeting in September when we return to school which will provide you with more information on the trip, including the payment plan and hire of ski wear.
