A-Level students at Fullbrook 6 in New Haw, part of Learning Partners Academy Trust, have once again achieved excellent A Level results. This year group faced an unusual challenge in that these were the first public examinations this year group had sat since their Year 6 SATs, as GCSEs were disrupted by the pandemic. Through hard work and determination, the number of grade A*s to Bs achieved by students at Fullbrook 6 has increased once again!

As a sixth form with a breadth of high performing subjects, we are proud to share some headlines. 67% of students achieved A*-A in Computer Science and 55% of students were awarded A*-A in Maths, while 57% of students were awarded A*-A in Product Design. 72% of students achieved A*-B in Law while 80% of students achieved A*-B in Economics, 83% of students achieved A*-B in Media studies and 100% of students achieved A*-B in Further Maths.

Students who particularly stood out with their results were Luke & Gabriella who achieved 3A*s and 1A, while Samantha was awarded 3A*s.

Congratulations to all our students and their parents and teachers for the hard work that has gone on this year culminating in all students achieving university places, apprenticeships, or employment of their choice. Destinations for further study include King's College London, Durham, Exeter, Southampton, Loughborough, Nottingham, Sussex, Bristol, Reading, Birmingham and Warwick, along with our higher education partner, The University of Surrey.

Fullbrook will continue to follow the aspirations and progress of the year group with interest. Our expectations for their success in the future are very high.
