- > Seating plans will be displayed on the F6 notice board in the week prior to the start of the exams.
- > Students should register in F6 using the finger-print registration system
- > Students should meet in the F6 building 30 minutes before the published start time of each exam
- > These assessments will be conducted as formal exams and follow the JCQ regulations for 2025-2026 - JCQ information for candidates can be found using the links on the exams page of the website <https://www.fullbrook.surrey.sch.uk/exams/>
- > Prohibited items; no phones or other electronic/smart devices, watches of any kind, notes, headphones, bags or coats. You should only bring the equipment as needed for the exam.
- > Please make sure you have all the equipment you need for your assessment in a clear and transparent bag or pencil case (equipment cannot be loaned in the exam room). No non-transparent pencil cases, calculator cases/lids, or maths tins are permitted.
- > Any water bottles must be clear, transparent, free from labels, images and writing of any kind (including measurements) - and only contain water. Sports cap lids are advisable to avoid spillages.
- > For assessments where calculators may be used, students are responsible for ensuring that nothing is stored in the memory, there are no pre-prepared programmes and it has been set to exam mode. Calculator cases are not permitted in the exam room. In exams which are 'non-calculator', calculators must not be brought into the exam room.
- > All students should display their F6 photo ID card on their exam room desk
- > Students must write in black pen and pencil should only be used for drawing unless otherwise stated in the instructions on the front of the exam paper. No gel or erasable pens. No correcting fluid. Highlighters may ONLY be used to highlight extracts or parts of questions and must not be used in your answers.
- > Extra time students should swap to green pen at the end of normal time (this is ONLY for mock and internal exams - never for the real public exams).
