- > All mocks take place in F6 (F11 & F13 is the main exam room. EAA of small or separate rooms will be F7 & F9), unless otherwise stated on the timetable. Morning assessments start at 9:00am and afternoon assessments start at 1:15pm
- > Students should register in F6 using the finger-print registration system, tick your name on the seating plan in the foyer and then wait in the foyer - the F6 team will take you to your exam room 10 minutes prior to the published start time.
- > These mock assessments will be conducted as formal exams and follow the JCQ regulations for 2024-2025 - JCQ information for candidates can be found using the links at the bottom of the exams page of the website <https://www.fullbrook.surrey.sch.uk/exams/>
- > Prohibited items (inc. phones, watches, smart/internet enabled technology, notes), bags and coats cannot be brought into the room. If you are unsure whether items are prohibited please check with the Exams Office - generally, unless it is required equipment for the paper that you are sitting, it will be a prohibited item. If you are wearing hooded clothing, please remember that the hood must remain down whilst inside examination rooms.
- > Please make sure you have all the equipment you need for your assessment in a clear and transparent bag or pencil case. We are unable to loan equipment in the exam room (except to replace a broken item during the exam).
- > Any water bottles must be clear, transparent, free from labels, writing, images and measurements and, only contain water. Sports caps are recommended to avoid spillages.
- > For assessments where calculators may be used, students are responsible for ensuring that nothing is stored in the memory and there are no pre-prepared programmes. Calculator cases, lids or operating instructions are not permitted in the exam room. Calculators should be set to exam mode.
- > All students must display their F6 photo ID card (face up) on their exam room desk
