The revised uniform policy will take effect from September 2026. To support families with this transition, the changes will be introduced over a phased period during the 2026–2027 academic year. As existing uniform items need replacing, we kindly ask that any new purchases comply with the updated policy.

We believe these changes strike an appropriate balance between affordability, practicality and maintaining high standards of presentation across the school.

School Uniform — Information for Parents

A guide to compulsory uniform and PE kit

This sheet outlines what your child needs for everyday school uniform and PE. Please read each section carefully and pay particular attention to items marked as compulsory.



Everyday School Uniform

Branded (compulsory)	Non-branded (compulsory)
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Fullbrook branded blazer• Fullbrook branded tie• Fullbrook branded pleated skirt (if a skirt is chosen instead of trousers)• Fullbrook branded V-neck jumper (good quality option, not compulsory)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Plain white shirt• Black straight-leg trousers (no skinny, flared or leggings-material trousers)• Navy blue V-neck jumper• Black school shoes. Sports trainers are not permitted.

Important – Year 7 skirts

The new style of pleated skirt is mandatory for all Year 7 students who choose to wear a skirt

Quality and Fit

- Trousers must be a traditional straight-leg cut. Skinny, flared, or leggings-material trousers are not permitted.

A Note on Quality and Fit

- PE bottoms must be plain navy blue with no contrasting logos or stripes
- Plain navy-blue PE shorts, not cycling shorts / or Lycra material
- No hoodies or sweatshirts are permitted
